

We will walk through Nunney Village, passing the moated castle and the church and then up Nunney Combe, beside the brook as far as Lower Whatley, then retracing our steps back to the village. Duration is between 90 mins and two hours.

We shall see snowdrops in the village and under trees beside the brook as it rushes through the deep combe.

The ground will in places be wet and could be very muddy. Please come prepared for this. There will be opportunities for photographing snowdrops in their wild setting.

If you would like to bring a hot or cold drink with you then there will be an opportunity to have this at the half way point when we will have a short break.

After the walk, you may wish to explore the castle ruin or the church. The Moat and Turret Cafe or the George Inn in the village are available for lunch.

Walkers will meet in the Car Park in Nunney for a 10.30am start.

Well behaved dogs kept on the lead are welcome.

There is a charge of £2.00 per person to help defray Festival expenses.

Directions

Leave Shepton Mallet on A 361, direction Frome. After 8 miles, at roundabout take turning direction Nunney. Drive down into village, turn left over bridge in direction of Whatley, Car Park (sign is visible at this point) is on right hand side, a short distance up the hill.
